- CLASS IS TAUGHT BY EITHER JULIA VELTEN OR NINA HEYDT


COURSE WORK: CULTURAL STUDIES


IF YOU DO NOT TAKE AN EXAM, YOU CAN EARN CREDIT FOR INDEPENDENT STUDIES


