

Scholarships for the U.S.

for applicants in the Obama Institute's Direct Exchange (Bachelor & Master)

Program: DAAD-Jahresstipendium (2 semesters)
Who can apply: students (2nd semester Bachelor or more advanced up to Master level)
Where & how: www.auslands-stipendien.de → Jahresstipendien für Studierende
Application deadline: late September of the year before departure
Funding: tuition up to 18.000 €, monthly scholarship, travel grant, insurance grant

Program: Fulbright Studienstipendium (1 or 2 semesters)
Who can apply: Master students & recent graduates (not U.S. citizens!)
Where & how: www.fulbright.de
Application deadline: late August for departure a year later or 16 months later
Funding: full scholarship incl. tuition

Program: Fulbright Travel Grant
Who can apply: Bachelor or Master students participating in an exchange program of their home university (1 or 2 semesters)
Where & how: www.fulbright.de
Application deadline: early February for a departure in August
Funding: travel grant of 2000 €

Program: PROMOS Studienstipendium (1 semester)
Who can apply: students enrolled at JGU
Where & how: jgu.to/studium/promos-studium
Application deadline: March 31 for departure in August of the same year
Funding: monthly partial scholarship, travel grant (no tuition!)

Program: AuslandsBAföG
Who can apply: students of a certain income group (see www.bafoeg-rechner.de/FAQ/ausland.php)
Where & how: www.bafög.de [sic] → Mit BAföG ins Ausland
Application deadline: at least 6 months before departure
Funding: tuition up to 5600 €, monthly partial scholarship, lump sum for travel & insurance (half of the AuslandsBAföG funding has to be repaid later, but *not* the tuition grant!)

Important: application deadlines and funding may vary from year to year – it is your responsibility to obtain the correct information!
