What are we doing?

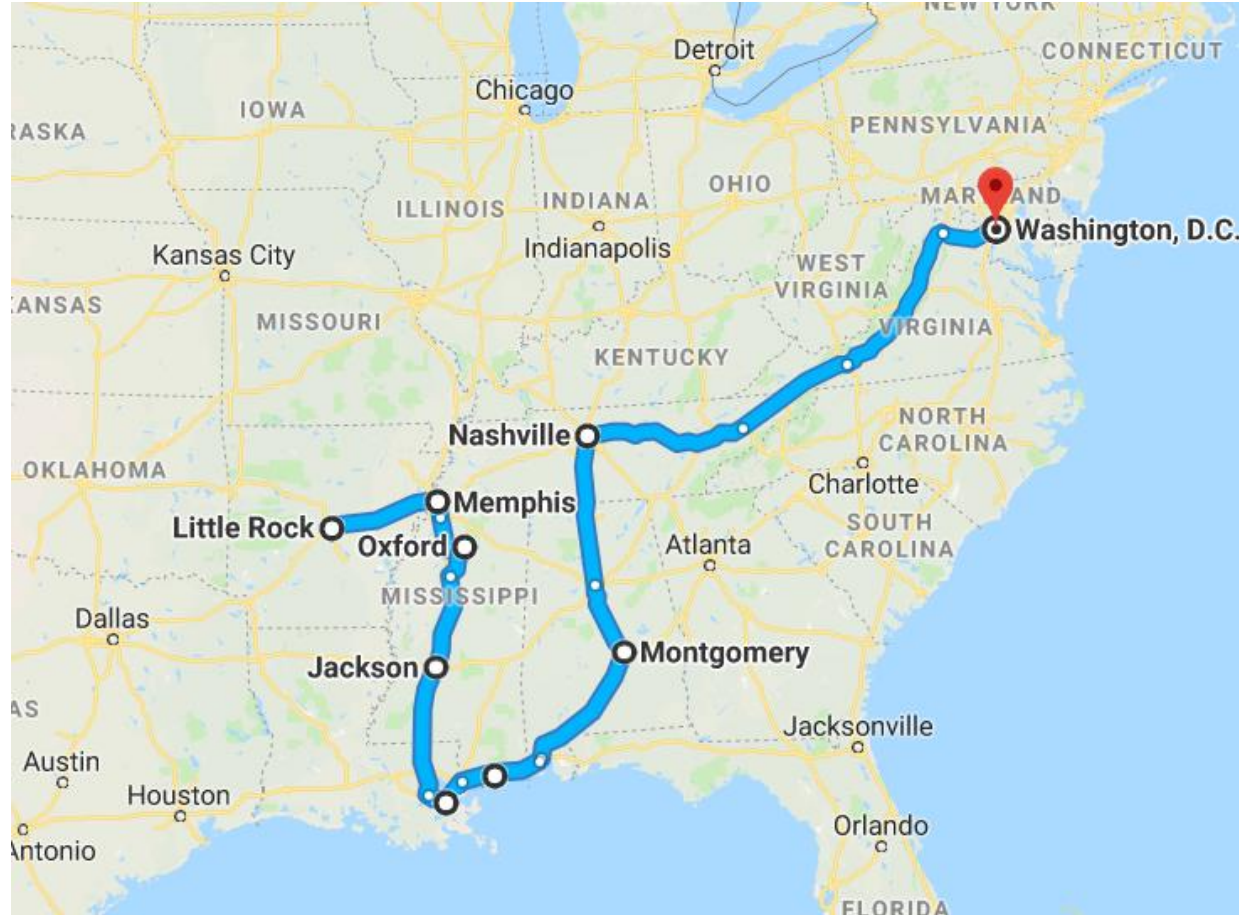

You can earn credits for either a Cultural Studies class OR a Written English class OR Independent Studies

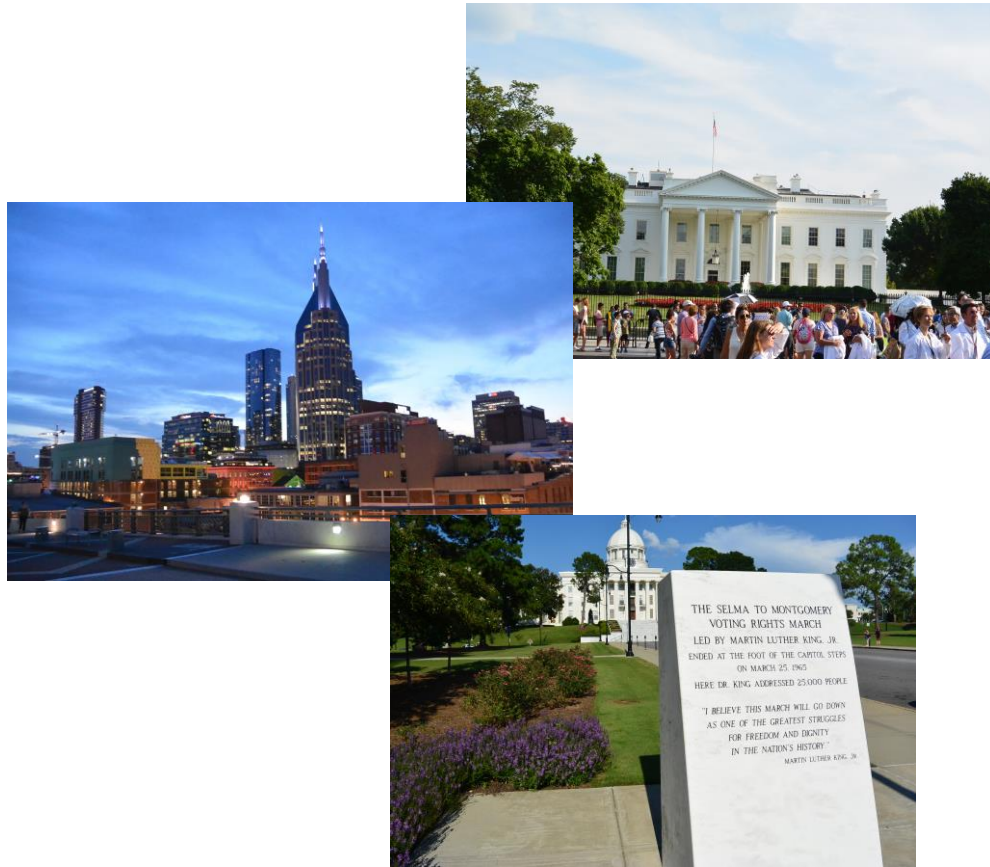
The three week program counts as FOUR WEEKS toward the obligatory stay abroad for B.Ed./M.Ed. students
